Suncream/ Sunhats

Please make sure that your child has suncream and sunhat (Labelled) that can be left at nursery. Although we do have spares here at nursery, the children having their own provides the opportunity of them learning to identify personal belongings. In addition to this, can we please ask that you check your child(rens) tubs regularly and remove/restock their items of clothing. Some of the children have outgrown their clothes and/or need additional clothing because they are toilet training. Please remember: if your child(ren) is/are toilet training, clothes that can be removed quickly is the order of the day. We try to teach the children to be independent when toilet training. Unfortunately, jeans/trousers with zips/buttons, dungarees etc. do not support this. Elasticated waists are best. Crocs, or Croc style shoes are great. These can be antibac'd, dried and put straight back on. Trainers tend to become soggy and smelly!
