Choosing a school for your child with SEND

Having an education, health and care (EHC) plan in place, or in draft form, for your child or young person gives them certain rights.

One of these is the legal right to request that a particular school or college is named in the EHC plan (or to express a preference for an independent school, nursery, college or other institution).



